### MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

#### FULL MEMBERS

<b>Senior Sailing</b>	Persons over the age of 18 who wish to sail
<b>Life</b>	Elected Life Members who wish to sail Elected Life Members, non-sailors
<b>Permanent Senior</b>	Permanent members who wish to sail Permanent members, non-sailing
<b>Senior Non Sailing</b>	Persons over the age of 18, non sailing

#### OTHER MEMBERS

<b>Social</b>	Community/public members
<b>Volunteer</b>	Person over the age of 18
<b>Junior</b>	Persons under the age of 18 as at 1 May in current year
<b>Affiliate</b>	Persons who are financial members of another sailing club affiliated with YA
<b>Temporary</b>	Persons participating in training or other events organised by the Club
<b>Family</b>	Individuals within a family group may jointly apply for membership of all eligible categories provided that at least two individuals are sailing members.
<b>Concession</b>	Is only available to Senior Sailing Members who are: (a) A student between the ages of 18 and 25 years (b) A member of Sailability SA Inc. (c) A pensioner over the age of 65 years Proof of concession to be submitted

<b><u>VOTING RIGHTS</u></b>	Full voting rights extend to the following categories: Life (sailing and non-sailing); Senior (sailing and non sailing); Permanent Senior (sailing and non-sailing).
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<b><u>NOTE</u></b>	Fees include GST, and for sailing categories, nomination fees, YSA levy and rescue boat levy. Should a member have financial difficulty in payment of subscriptions an application may be made in writing to the Management Committee for special consideration.
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<b><u>MEMBER BENEFITS</u></b>	A Family Group jointly applying/renewing membership will be eligible for a discount of 15% off their total fees.  Junior Membership includes participation in Saturday morning coaching clinics.  All members over the age of 18 years will be issued with a Membership Card (one per Family Membership group) which can be used to obtain a 10% discount off the full price of meals purchased for themselves and their guests in the Galley on Friday nights (excluding functions).  All members over the age of 18 years are eligible to win the "Members Draw" if they are at the Club on Friday nights (excluding functions).  All members are entitled to a 20% discount off the normal price of hiring either the Mariners Bar or Upper Deck for a private function at the Club.
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
